
Although it is understood that in our industry the risk is minimal in comparison to others, we have a responsibility to be alert to the risks however small and ensure that due diligence is applied at all times.

It is the duty of Directors , Managers and Decision Makers of the company to ensure that management controls and resources are suitably applied to eliminate any potential risk.


A full copy of the Modern Slavery Act is accessible to all employees electronically on the shared drive along with this statement .
